Ephesians 4:15b Amplified Bible says "let us grow up in all things into Him (following His example) who is the Head Christ.



Christ.








John 15:5-6

- ☐ that I might <u>not</u> <u>sin</u> against thee.




II Timothy 3:16-17 AMP

5. Read James 1:22-25. How did James say we should respond to the

word of God?

James 1:22-25 MSG

- Don't **fool yourself** into thinking that you are a listener when you are anything but, letting the Word go in **one ear** and out the other.
- Act on what you hear!
- Those who hear and don't act are like those who glance in the mirror, walk away, and two minutes later have no idea who they are, what they look like.
- ❖ 25 But whoever catches a glimpse of the revealed counsel of God—the free life!—even out of the corner of his eye, and sticks with it, is no distracted scatterbrain but a man or woman of action. That person will find delight and affirmation in the action.








ANSWER




Psalm 1:1-3 KJV
