- 1. Read Nehemiah 5:1-5 and describe at least three injustices that Nehemiah had to speak out against that still happen in our community today?**
- 2. Godly leaders must hear and feel the cry of oppressed people in their community. How did Nehemiah show that he heard the people and felt their pain?**
- 3. Godly leaders must be willing to confront the powerful oppressors and the conditions they create in the community. How did Nehemiah confront oppression and oppressors?**
- 4. One of the main weapons against oppression and injustice in the civil rights movement is the mass meeting. Where in this chapter do you see that Nehemiah organized a mass meeting and the purpose of the meeting?**
- 5. How did the oppressors respond to Nehemiah and the people during the mass meeting?**
- 6. Godly leaders must show their willingness to work with the people and lead by example. How did Nehemiah lead by example and encourage the people through his own actions?**
- 7. Nehemiah also demonstrated what I call the “leadership tithe” meaning leaders give their time, talent, and money to struggle of the people. Where in this chapter does Nehemiah give the “leadership tithe”?**
- 8. What did Nehemiah say and do that showed he trusted God to take care of him and bless him for his faithfulness?**
