BIBLE STUDY ASSIGNMENT – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 6, 2022
READ: MARK CHAPTER 11 AND LUKE CHAPTER 19
“WHO’S IN THE CROWD?”

On APRIL 6, 2022, we will study the **TRIUMPHAL ENTRY OF JESUS** in Mark Chapter 11 and Luke Chapter 19 by looking at the question “**WHO’S IN THE CROWD?**” We will study Jesus’ final journey to Jerusalem and that shout of “**Hosanna!**” and answer who was that crowd. Come travel with Jesus to the Cross. Please answer the following questions:

1. In Mark 11:1-7, Jesus and his disciples are walking from Jericho to Jerusalem. In this text we see the **Triumphal Entry of Jesus**, which gives us **Palm Sunday**. Why did Jesus send two of his disciples to find a donkey and which Old Testament prophecy is fulfilled by this action?

2. In **Luke 19:41** Jesus weeps over Jerusalem. How many times does Jesus weep in the Gospels and why do you think he wept in this verse?

3. In **Mark 11:8-10** Jesus rides into Jerusalem on the donkey he sent for and the crowd started shouting Hosanna, Hosanna! What did Hosanna mean and why were the crowds so excited to see Jesus ride into town?

4. **Mark 11:11** says Jesus looked around the Temple courtyards and then he and his disciples went to Bethany. Who lived in Bethany and had Jesus ever gone there before?

5. How would you explain the purpose of Jesus cursing of the fig tree in **Mark 11:12-14**?

6. Who were the scribes and chief priests in **Mark 11:18** and what was it that Jesus said that made them angry enough to plan to kill him?

7. The next morning, when Jesus and his disciples were heading back from Bethany to Jerusalem, what was the meaning of the withered and dead fig tree in **Mark 11:20**?
