6. Dr. Stewart used the word "Propaganda". What information did she share concerning the word "Propaganda"?

ANSWER: Dr. Stewart shared that propaganda is rooted in misinformation and rooted in falsehood. "It is the manipulation and framing of narratives political and otherwise that is rooted in biases in nature that is used to promote or publicize a particular view or a particular cause. She shares that propaganda is also the following:

- ✓ Propaganda "is not objective, it's used to influence an audience who does not read, it's used to influence and audience that does not stay abreast of the circumstances, it's used to influence an audience who does not use their critical thinking. It is used to further an agenda by selecting and presenting facts to present a particular synthesis or perception or using loaded language to produce a response to information that is biased and rooted in falsehood. Its information, ideas and rumors deliberately spread widely to help harm a person, institution, a cause or a nation. It's deceptive, it's biases, it's misleading, it's half-truths, designed to persuade and manipulate the masses into believing a lie."
- ✓ Propaganda as stated by Dr. Gina Stewart.
 - A tactic that Hitler used to come to power.
 - The Nazis allowed a course uneducated leader to rise to prominence on white privilege.
 - The Nazi party destroyed media credibility to silence critics.
 - It's the distrust of Journalism and freedom of the press by calling it fake news.
 - Fire hose of falsehood.
 - Stolen election. Spending your tax money and my tax money for rigged voting election. Voter fraud.
 - Lying about a virus that killed over a million people.
 - Destroys institutions, churches, conventions!
 - It's rooted in lies. It's rooted in falsehood.
 - Social media amplifies messaging and anybody with a microphone and a smart phone can get on a platform and go viral through the power of mass replication, even when it's not true, discerning fact from fiction is critical for all of us.

ANSWER

- Jesus challenged their traditions
- Jesus cleaned house in the temple
- Jesus called people from religion to relationship
- Jesus exposed their hypocrisy
- Jesus challenged their morals
- Jesus engaged with people of questionable characters
- Jesus is healing on the sabbath and acting out in ways that make leaders bristle with contempt
- Jesus invited women into his fellowship
- Jesus is getting women to follow him
- Jesus has women as disciples
- Jesus is treating women as equals
- Jesus engaged in theological discourse and a conversation with the woman at the well who everyone thought is a social outcast
- Jesus commissioned the woman at the well to run a revival in the city and the folks got saved
- Jesus actively sort out and engaged with individuals who were often excluded from society
- Jesus dined with tax collectors, he healed lepers, he had social intercourse with those who were deemed to be sinners.

9. Dr. Stewart said Jesus rebuked "Social hierarchy". What is the meaning of Social hierarchy per Dr. Gina Stewart?

ANSWER: Social hierarchy breaks down communities, social hierarchy is someone wanting to be over you instead of with you, social hierarchy contributes to oppression. Jesus leveled the playing field for everybody, he confronted religious leaders who exploited their positions, he rebuked aggressive practices, he restored dignity and gave wholeness to people who were marginalized and dismissed, they can't control Jesus, they can't make him shut up, when you want stop talking, when they say you don't cooperate, they put you on a black list, He won't cosign on their foolishness and he won't cosign on their self-serving agendas, His unconventional approach their methods and hypocrisy in their religious establishments.

10. Dr. Stewart said that the religion leaders used their spirituality as a smokescreen? Can you elaborate on what she stated as a "smokescreen?"

ANSWER:

- The religion leaders used their spirituality as a "smokescreen." She said stop using your spirituality as a smokescreen.
- Dr. Stewart summons religion people to stop using spirituality as a smokescreen (cover up) and blaming God for all this stuff.

- The power to deliver Jesus.

ANSWER: Pilate succumbed to "political pressure and fear". Despite recognizing Jesus innocence, Pilate chose expediency over righteousness. Faced with the choice of between moral courage and appeasing the crowd, Pilate relinquished his power and ordered Jesus Crucifixion.
