2. What does David encourage others to do at the end of Psalm 27?
3. What is David's basis of confidence in verse 13?
4. What does David advise in verse 14 about waiting on the Lord?
5. How can you practice waiting on God in your own life?
6. How can you apply the themes of trust, seeking God, and patience in your current situation?
7. How does David's declaration in verse 13 ("I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living") reveal his perspective on God's timing?
8. What is the importance of the exhortation in verse 14 to "wait for the Lord"?
9. How does the concept of "waiting on the Lord" (verse 14) apply to the overall message of Psalm 27?
